Miles and Steve Brown Duo Friday, July 20 8pm

Guitarist Steve Brown, is a Professor Emeritus of music and creator of the Jazz Studies, the Jazz Guitar, and Classical Guitar programs at Ithaca College. Known widely for his playing as well as his career as an educator, he has released several successful records. Bassist, composer, performer, and teacher Miles Brown began playing the bass at an early age. An avid jazz educator as well as performer, Miles has served Director of Jazz at Cornell University, Oakland University and recently joined the faculty of the University of Delaware as Instructor of Double Bass and Jazz. Chaise Lounge Saturday, July 28 8pm

Chaise Lounge performs a blend of music that sounds like it was recorded at Capitol Recording Studios in 1962 and somehow found its way to today's pop charts. You might call it "Early Stereo." Or perhaps Lounge with a capital "L." Or maybe just plain enjoyable. It is the combination of five of the Washington area's top jazz musicians playing sparkling arrangements of standards and original tunes and featuring the soft, luminous vocals of Marilyn Older. RUNA Thursday, August 2 8pm

Quickly gaining recognition as one of Irish music's new "super-groups," RUNA has been enchanting audiences by pushing the boundaries of Irish folk music into the Americana and roots music formats since their formation in 2008. Interweaving the haunting melodies and exuberant tunes of Ireland and Scotland with the lush harmonies and intoxicating rhythms of jazz, bluegrass, blues, they offer a thrilling take on traditional music. RUNA recently released their 5th album, RUNA: LIVE, which was recorded at the BlackRock Center for the Arts in Germantown, MD. Receiving lavish praise on both sides of the Atlantic, the album has been hailed as "an incredible masterpiece" - Marcene Bronson, The Celtic Crier. He creates jazz music steeped in hard bop, modal, fusion, and avant-garde styles. Most recently SUPERNOVA® was selected by the US State Department and the Lincoln Center as Ambassadors to tour with the American Music Abroad Rhythm Road. Bumper Jacksons are hot and sweet, painting America's story from the streets of New Orleans to Appalachian hollers. Powerhouse vocals are flanked by a New Orleans-style horn section on one side and a dynamic pedal steel on the other.
